

Christmas Card Book Ideas

Use your old Christmas cards to make a book that spells and illustrates the word "Christmas." I used the words to the song by Jim Reeves, *C is for the Christ Child*. Simply find a Christmas Card picture to match each line.

C is for the Christ Child born upon this day (Manger)
H is for Herald Angels in the night (Angels)
R means our redeemer (Baby Jesus)
I means Israel (Picture of Bethlehem)
S is for the star that shone so bright (Star)
T is for three wise men they who travelled far (3 Kings)
M is for the manger where he lay (Another Manger scene)
A's for all he stands for (Card that says Peace or Joy)
S means shepherds came (Shepherds)
And that's why there's a Christmas day (Merry Christmas card or Tree or wreath, many choices)

Print one line on each page and add your Christmas Card picture. Put the pages in a binder or folder to make your book!

You Can also make an entire ABC Book, coming up with words for every letter! Trickier, but fun!
